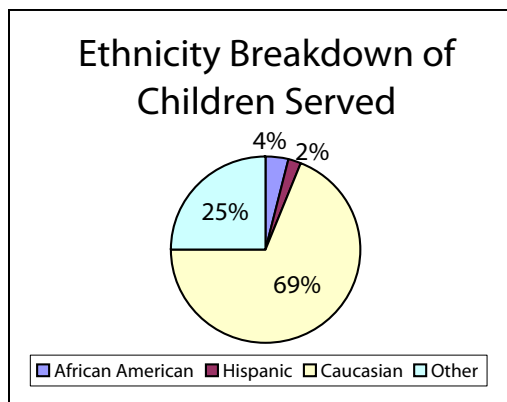




Big Brothers Big Sisters enriches, encourages and empowers children to reach their highest potential through safe, positive mentoring relationships.

Key finding of BBBS Alumni: A 2008 Harris Interactive Research Study of adults who were formerly Little Brothers and Little Sisters culminated in the following results:

90% agree that their Big made them feel better about themselves

77% did better in school than their peers

76% learned right from wrong from their Big

90% believe their Big provided stability when they needed it

72% are extremely satisfied with their relationship to friends

76% learned about the importance of helping others from their Big

77% agree that their Big helped them make better choices

75% more likely to earn a four-year college degree
